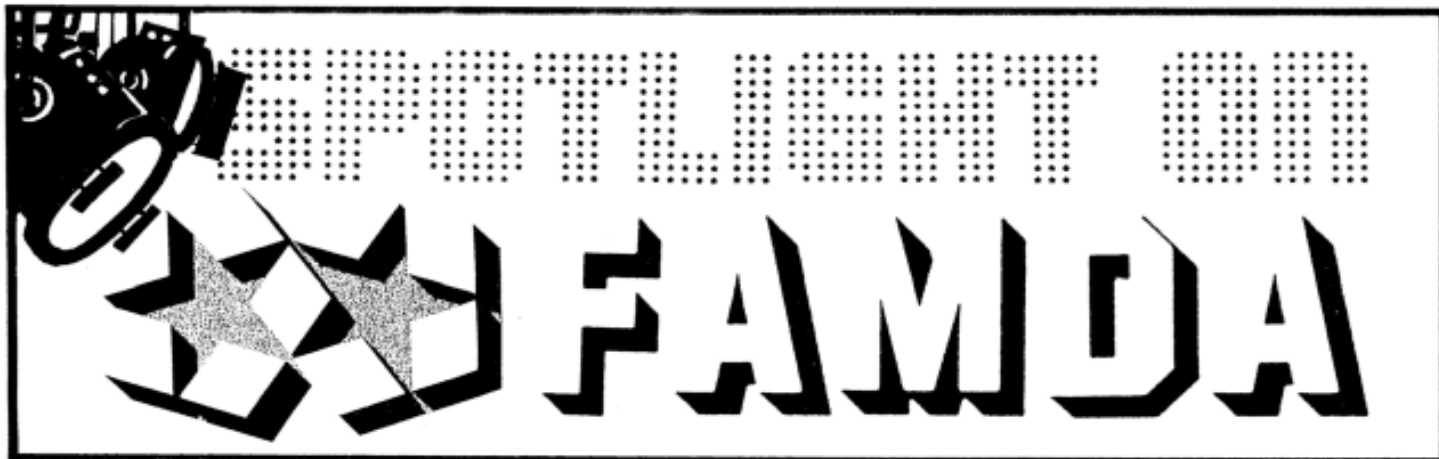

TWO NIGHTS ONLY — FRIDAY 1 & SATURDAY 2 OCTOBER

PARIS BERLIN NEW YORK BUENOS AIRES FOSTER

The first cabaret was in Paris, probably *Le Chat Noir* in Montmartre in 1881, with other venues such as *Moulin Rouge*, *Folies Bergère* and *Le Lido*. In Berlin between the wars, kabaret was a satirical and subversive alternative entertainment in the face of the economic and political turmoil of pre-war Germany. In New York, cabaret developed as part of the nightclubs that grew out of the speakeasies of the prohibition era and included burlesque, jazz and the sort of variety portrayed in numerous Hollywood movies.

Now it's Foster's turn to experience sophisticated entertainment in a small venue with the audience dining.
