



17th Annual South Gippsland One Act Play Festival Entry Form Saturday 19 & Sunday 20 August, 2017

Hello to all theatre companies and youth theatrical groups,

We invite you to join us for our 17th South Gippsland One Act Play Festival hosted by Foster Arts Music and Drama Association.

Registrations are open for both Youth and the Adult section of the Festival. **Youth** is defined as being **under 19** years of age.

Plays must have a minimum of 2 performers. Adult plays ideally 15 – 50 minutes (55 max). Youth plays 10 – 20 minutes (30 max).

Companies entering more than one play in the Festival must complete a separate entry form for each play.

Please note your application is not a confirmation of acceptance. You will be notified by July 28, if your play has been included in the festival program.

All entrants (directors, actors, stage crew etc.) must be performing on an amateur basis.

The registration fee per adult play entry is **\$50** and **\$20** for youth play entries, payable in advance, however a refund will be sent to you if your play has not been selected for inclusion in the festival.

All entrants are responsible for the payment of royalties associated with their play.

Registration includes 6 Festival entry tickets.

(Festival ticket prices \$10 per session, or Festival pass \$25. Young Players Festival – Adults \$5, Children free)

Closing date for registrations is Monday 18th July, 2016.

Set up requirements: Company to be at the theatre 1 hour before performance time.
Bump in time 10 minutes maximum, bump out 5 minutes maximum.
Parking in front and behind theatre. There are 2 dressing rooms.

Staging details: We provide a full set of blacks, a manual light dimmer and good stage lighting.
A CD player is plugged into front of house speakers. You can use mp3 files brought in on a USB stick .
A microphone and amplifier are also available.
Standard chairs, a table and carpet square are available with notification before the festival.
A stage plan can be emailed out if required.
All companies must provide a Stage Manager.
FAMDA members are available backstage to help things run smoothly, but if our help is needed we expect to work at the direction of the company.

Any special requirements need to be arranged well before the Festival dates.
