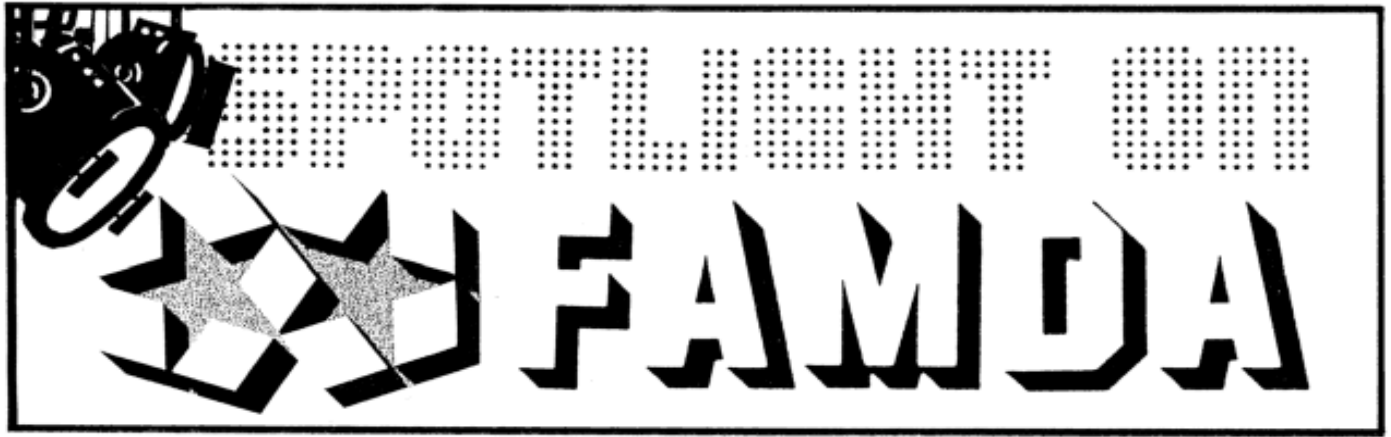

Raymond Dunstan is directing the production and Lloyd Morcom is Hugo.

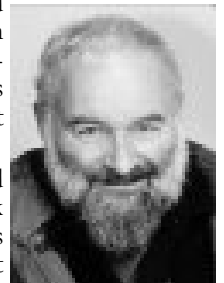
His guests are played by Sue Dower, Jean Moore, Norm Wiloughby, James McIntyre, Jo Street and Sacha Lamont.

Lieutenant George Bass was 27 years old in 1797 when he and his crew of six sailors saw and mapped the coast of Wilsons Promontory and called it "the cornerstone of this great island".
