

In April, the FAMDA Annual General Meeting was an excellent evening. Edwin, our outgoing president arranged a small talk by Harley McDonald-Eckersall, Leuca Maclean and Louis Wheeler whom we sponsored to the Victorian Drama League Junior Summer School. They gave a most impressive and informative talk of their experiences. We were also entertained by the very talented violinist and all round musician, Fiona Watts.

Rehearsals are now well under way for our latest musical 'Bugsy Malone' with a cast of over 45 children. In fact, apart from the pianist, nobody in the cast is older than 16! Our director (and Musical Director) Pamela Coad ably assisted by Sue Dower are doing a magnificent job. If you can assist with front of house, back stage or lighting please contact either Edwin Coad or myself.

Keep the weekend of August 9 and 10 free for our annual one act play festival. I believe FAMDA will be entering an original play this year.

Our second production for this year is the highly acclaimed Ronald Harwood comedy, 'Quartet', to be staged in early October. Watch out for further news of auditions and times.

We are also looking at producing a locally written musical set in the Sandy Point area featuring Australian songs from the 60s. It is hoped this will be performed in April 2015 for the Sea Change Festival.

Also in that month FAMDA, in conjunction with the RSL, will be performing a locally written one act play for the centenary of the ANZAC Landing.

We have identified a number of improvements to the back stage area of the F.W.M.A.C. in the form of communications, audio and lighting. These will be implemented over the coming months and should result in an enhancement in production management especially for the one act play festival.

From the mean streets of New York 1929, to the mean streets of Foster 2014 - FAMDA is about to stage **Bugsy Malone** with a cast of 45 talented and enthusiastic young performers.

The original film, written and directed by Alan Parker, has been adapted for the stage by the director and the song-writer Paul Williams. It is probably unique in that the film and play are both designed with adult characters played by young actors and that's the way FAMDA is playing it.

Bugsy, a man about town living in the dangerous streets of the prohibition era 1920's finds himself in the middle of a gang war between Fat Sam Stacetto and Dandy Dan fighting over control of the illegal sarsaparilla trade and the speakeasies.

Bugsy Malone creates a world where the splurge gun is a secret weapon and a custard pie can be life-threatening and where a young singer dreams of making it big in Hollywood.
