

'I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change' celebrates the agonies and triumphs of the mating game, from dating and finding love to marriage and in-laws. It needs talented singer / actors to play multiple roles to bring to life its 56 characters.

All auditionees should prepare 16 bars of a song that shows off their vocal range. Actors should be prepared to read from the script. Roles are available for performers aged 18 and up.

The show was originally cast with four cast members (2 men; 2 women) aged 25—35. These cast members create the show's 56 different characters. A few of those characters are soppy parents, quarrelling lovers, egotistical one-night stands and senior romantics.

The actors must be versatile and have strong comic timing.

All four must be capable of singing both strong solos and close harmonies. It is not a dance intensive show; there is only a couple of choreography numbers/sequences.

The main challenge for actors will be to create a variety of comedic characters.

WOMAN 1 – Female – able to play 20s to early 30s. Soprano

WOMAN 2 – Female – able to play late 20s to early 40s. Alto

MAN 1 – Male – able to play 20s to late 30s. Baritone-Tenor

MAN 2 – Male – able to play late 20s to early 40s. Baritone

We may expand the cast to include up to six cast members (even up to 4 men and 4 women) which would allow us to expand the character age range accordingly.
